Sell your staff

- Social enterprise concepts

Sell your staff – continued

- Discussion on ideas
 - Private home care company, maybe a franchise
 - Cafe that benefits Meals on Wheels
 - Sell caterer's brownies at delis/coffee shops
 - E shop that sells shirts, mugs, greeting cards, etc.
 - Mature staffing company
 - Chore service
 - Travel service
 - Snow cone shop
 - Food truck

Sell your staff - continued

- Narrow down ideas based upon staff discussion
- Brainstorm with staff
- Get buy in from existing staff no one person can do this

Sell your Board


- Talk with Board chair first
- Buy in from Executive Committee through presentation similar to staff presentation
- BUSINESS PLAN!
- Presentation to full Board (staff PowerPoint)
- Prime a couple of Board members ahead of time

Sell the Market

- Preview with staff
- Soft opening with invited guests
- Low key first event
- Social media

Business Plan

- Business school at local university, tech school or SCORE
- Review by relevant audience (technical) and unrelated audience (non-technical)

Elements in Business Plan

- Executive Summary purpose, need, concept, customers, market research and brief financial forecast
- About management, funding needed, competitors, sourcing, personnel, purchase of a food truck, regulatory considerations, exit strategy
- Customers target market, market trends, industry analysis
- Marketing & Sales overview, positioning, pricing, promotion

Elements in Business Plan – cont.

- Strategy & implementation milestones,
 SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats)
 analysis, competitive edge, strategic alliances
- Financial Plan sales forecast, budget

Top Ten Reasons Why Food Truck Businesses Fail

2. No identity.






