2021 Meals on Wheels Loves Pets Grant





SUMMARY

The 2021 Meals on Wheels Loves Pets grant will invest in Member organizations delivering support to their Meals on Wheels clients and pets. Successful applicants will show that their existing and/or new proposed pet program reduces social isolation for seniors by ensuring that seniors and their animal companions can live nourished, healthy lives, together.

Thanks to our generous partner, PetSmart Charities, Meals on Wheels America will award grants of variable amounts ranging from \$2,500 to \$15,000+ to applicants who are creating new and/or expanding existing programs that support their clients' pets. The grant period will last up to twelve months depending on the amount of funding awarded. All grants will begin on or around July 1, 2021 and end with a final report due on July 15, 2022.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be an active dues-paying Member of Meals on Wheels America, remain in good standing through at least December 31, 2022, agree to the Terms and Conditions of participation, and comply with other eligibility requirements listed at the beginning of the application.

DEADLINE TO APPLY: Applications must be submitted by **5:00 PM Eastern Time on Monday**, May 24, 2021.

- demonstrate a clear plan for utilizing funds;
- maintain active nonprofit or government tax-exempt status;
- have the current Meals on Wheels America Member Badge (or approved local version of the national brand), located here, on your organization's website*;
- provide demographics, data, stories, and photos to Meals on Wheels America around your current or developing pet program services along with deliverables listed below;
- agree to expend all funds within the grant time period;
- submit all required reports via the Online Grants Management System by the date listed below; and
- adhere to all terms and conditions for this grant program.

Goals of Funding: The goals of this grant program are to increase the number of Members offering pet programs, increase the number of seniors and pets benefiting from services and increase the types of services offered by those programs to meet the seniors' needs.

Use of Funds: Grant funds may be utilized for:

- Basic pet food & supplies (e.g., cat litter, carriers, leashes, crates, storage, etc.)
- Capacity building (e.g., volunteer recruitment and retention)
- Veterinary care (e.g., preventative, emergency, and sick care)
- Transportation support and development (e.g., delivery and transport for pet care)
- Other pet services (e.g., pet grooming, boarding, walking)

Non-funded Activities:

- As-needed emergency funds (i.e., a pool of funds set aside for when urgent needs arise, but without a specific plan for use)
- Pet adoption

Up to 10% of funds may be used for general administrative costs and/or in-direct operating expenses.

You will be asked to outline your planned spending in the Budget Template later in this application.

Range of Funding: This grant has variable options of funding from \$2,500 to \$15,000+, with the majority of applications funded at or around the \$5,000 level. The highest levels of funding are designated to support expanded access to veterinary care. Applicants intending to provide veterinary care will be required to indicate a local partner (i.e., high volume, low-cost vet clinic, humane society, etc.). Grantees can expect technical assistance provided in the form of education and training webinars, on-demand resources, Meals on Wheels Connect (peer-to-peer communication platform), annual conference and in some cases, site visits. Technical assistance will be commensurate with funding.

Timing of Program: Up to 12 months with all funds to be expended by Friday, July 1, 2022

Reporting: A Final Report must be completed and submitted by the grantee on or before July 15, 2022. For your awareness before submitting this application, a preview of the Final Report can be viewed **HERE**. Expectations for the Final Report will vary depending on the level of funding received. Changes may be made to this Final Report before final posting in the Online Grants Management System.

Agreements: Recipients will be required to agree to the **Terms and Conditions** of the grant prior to the initial disbursement of funds.
